Gina:: Gina is a second generation belty dancer who has performed on national and international stages throughout her lengthy career with notable artists such as Alabina, Amr Diab and Hakim. Her technique combines both fusion and classical styles. Gina began her studies with Suhaila Salimpour in 1994 and was one of the first and youngest members of the Suhaila Dance Company. Gina is currently certified in Level Three of the Suhaila Salimpour Format-tonight's performance constitutes her Level Four examination.

Sabriye Tekbilek :: Daughter of renowned Turkish musician, "Haci" Ahmet Tekbilek and Lisa Djeylan, pioneer of belly dance in Sweden, Sabriye's career as a performer and instructor of Middle Eastern dance has been shaped by a lifetime of international performance and study. Sabriye was a longtime member of Suhalia Dance Company and Bal Anat--and was featured in the original run of Suhalia's stage show Sheherazade as well as videos for Bal Anat, The Suhalia Dance Company and Suhalia's Bellydance Fitness Fusion Series. Sabriye is currently certified in Level Three of the Suhalia Salimpour Format--tonight's performance constitutes her Level Four Examination.

Rashid :: Under the tutelage of Jamita Salimpour, Rashid immersed himself in Arabic dance at age sixteen. He vigorously pursued Middle Eastern dance study as a performer, anthropologist and historian--studying under many great artists including Lala Hakim, Nadia Gamal and Mahmoud Reda, Rashid quickly became a principal dancer with Bal Anat and has been a contributing artist to the Salimpour schools for over thirty years. Featured on both the *Sheherazade* and Solo Show DVDs, Rashid continues his work as a teacher, choreographer, performer and artistic consultant with the Suhaila Salimpour School of Dance.

Suhalla is the world's most sought-after performer, teacher, and choreographer of belly dance. A second generation belly dancer, Suhalla has developed a format combining her heritage with classical dance training. The first belly dancer to be featured on Arab American television, Suhalla foured the Middle East and Europe-returning to open her school. She has developed and offered the first certification program available in belly dance. The program offers a multi-disciplinary approach addressing technique, physiology, history, music theory, choreography and personal development of choreography. Suhaila continues to create and release instructional and performance DVDs for all dance levels, music for percussion artists, and printed dance manuals. Upcoming projects include a line of CDs with drills for dancers and a new comprehensive book outlining the Suhaila Salimpour pedagogy and curriculum.

Mr. Aljarah immigrated to the United States in 1996 — in addition to his work as a musician and composer — he is a high-end electrical engineer working in the Silicon Valley.
